







Advertiser (Free Sign Up) / Publisher registration page:

- In Sign Up page you can register as Advertiser / Publisher.



Advertiser Sign Up with Payment Gateway (PayPal):

- In Sign Up page you can register as Advertiser.



- In Sign Up page you can register as Advertiser.

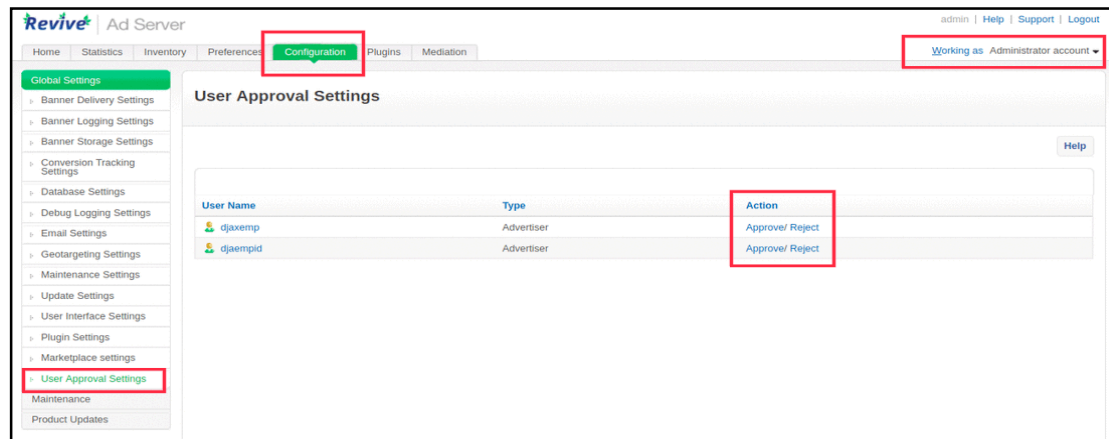

- Once payment type is selected as Authorize.net, It will show the additional fields such as Credit card details and Payable Amount in the sign up page.
- After filling all the fields in sign up page, the payment transaction will be done in backend on clicking the Register option. If the entered credit card details are invalid, an alert message will be displayed. Once the payment is done advertiser user gets registered.

User Approval:

- Once registered as advertiser (Free / Paid) / publisher, the registered users will be listed in the admin 'User Approval Settings' page.
- Login as Administrator → Configuration → User Approval Settings → Admin can Approve / Reject the users.

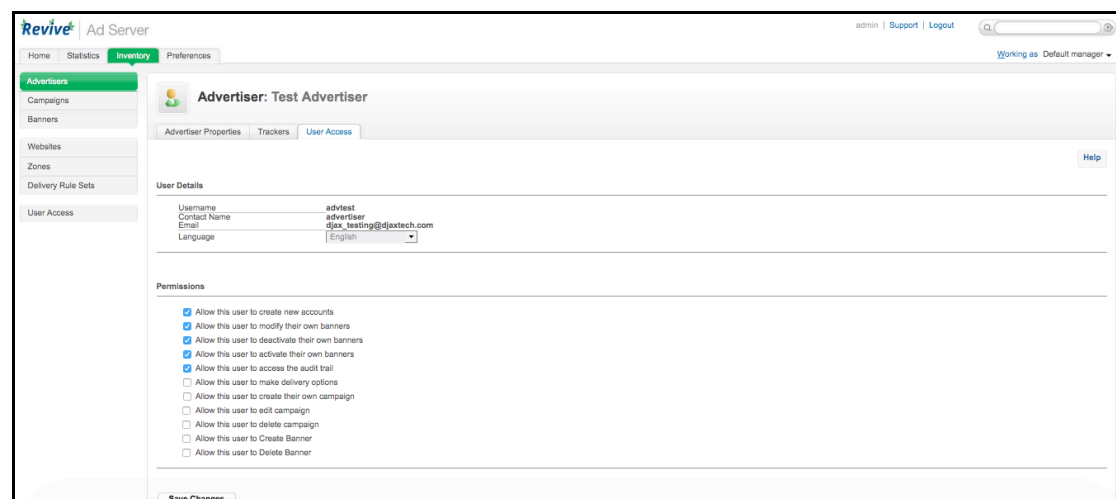


- Registered users can be able to login only after admin approval.
- Once after admin approval / rejection, email notification will be sent to respective users.

User Permission Settings:

Advertiser:

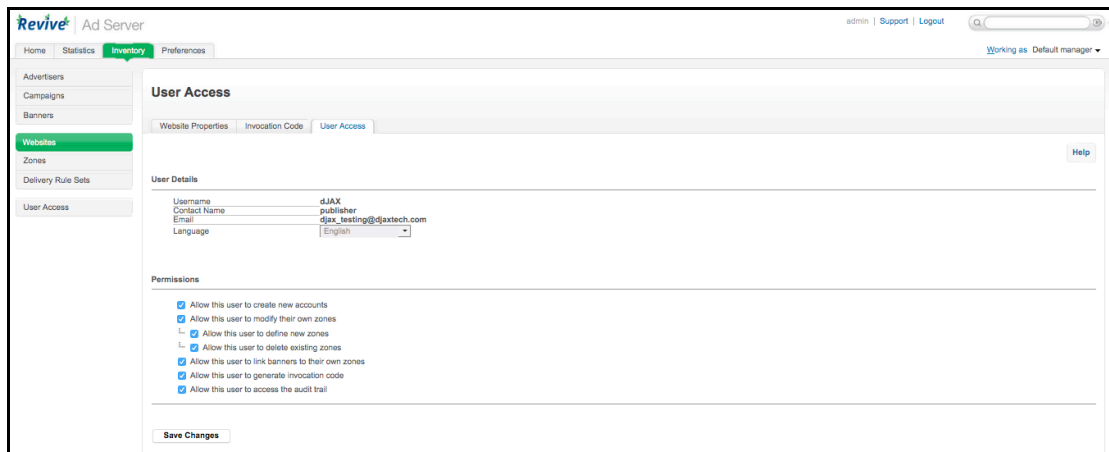
- Login as Default Manager → Inventory → Advertisers → Choose Advertiser → Edit Advertiser → Navigate to User Access tab.
- In User Access page, click on Permissions (Initially the advertiser was given default permissions).



- Admin can provide access to user by checking and unchecking the check box.
- For example**, check the permission "Allow user to create their own Campaign" and save, it will allow the user to create a campaign in advertiser panel and if that check box is unchecked that feature would be disabled in advertiser panel.

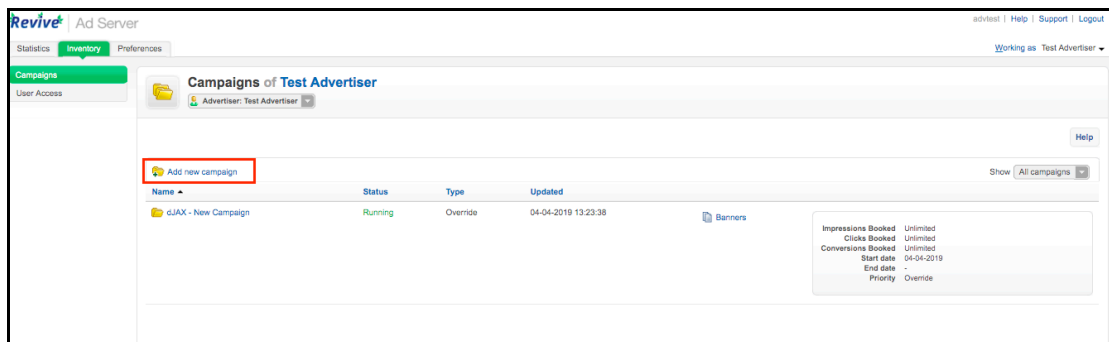
Publisher:

- Login as Default Manager → Inventory → Websites → Choose website → Edit website → Navigate to User Access tab.
- Publishers have all the default permissions.



Advertiser Login:

- After admin approval, Login as Advertiser → Advertiser gets the access to the features which admin has enabled.



- For example, default manager checks the permission “Allow user to create their own Campaign” in admin login. So the user in advertiser panel got the access to create campaigns.

Publisher Login:

- After admin approval, Login as Publisher → Publishers have all the default permissions.
